What do I do if my child has lost a piece of clothing?

Please make sure all clothing is clearly marked with your child's name so that it can be returned when found. If an item goes missing, please send a note or contact the school on (026) 44107 or (086) 794 3289. We will do our utmost to find lost items.

What should I do if I think my child has special educational needs / learning difficulties?

Speak to the Class Teacher / Principal to discuss your concerns. They will be able to discuss what progress your child is making and any additional support that can be offered. We have extra teaching supports available for children with learning difficulties, educational assessments and special needs programme.

The school is wheelchair accessible.



What should I do if my child is not well / absent from school?

If your child is unwell, it is best if he/she is kept at home. Please advise the school by sending in a note or text 086 – 794 3289 if your child is absent.



What do I need to do if I want to transfer my child from another school to Carriganima National School?

You need to complete an enrolment form which can be downloaded from the Enrolment Tab in the school website or contact the school office on 026 – 44107 or 086 794 3289. You can visit the school anytime and see what we have to offer. We welcome children from all parts of our community and surrounding areas and we accept enrolments for all classes at any stage throughout the year. All enquiries are welcome.

What happens if my child has an accident or become unwell at school?

Unfortunately, sometimes children do have accidents or become unwell whilst they are at school and we need to call you. Please ensure that we have up to date contact telephone number. School staff will treat minor cuts, scratches/bruises if you have already agreed to this on the enrolment form.

Is there a Parents Association in the school?

Yes. The Parents Association meet regularly to organise a range of social events throughout the year with the aim of bringing together the school community and fundraising for the school. More information can be found under the Parents tab on the school website.

What should I put in my child's packed lunch?

We encourage healthy eating and expect parents to choose healthily when creating a packed lunch (i.e. sandwich, fruit, yogurt, water/juice). No crisps, chewing gum, fizzy drinks, lollipops or glass bottles. We have a Healthy Lunch Policy in place. Friday is treat day which is optional.

I am worried my child will not eat much for lunch/is a fussy eater. What should I do?

Our SNA's supervise during break-time and they support and encourage the children to eat their lunch. If they notice an issue they will let the class teacher know. If the issue continues, parents will be notified.
